### AUGUST 20: DISCOVER CAPE TOWN

### AUGUST 25: GROOTBOS PRIVATE NATURE RESERVE

Exploration of the magnificent Cape Floral Kingdom with more than 750 fynbos species, 107 bird species, 21 mammals and 21 reptiles — travel out by 4x4 with our guides to learn about the mosaic of habitats and interactions that contribute to this wondrous location — visit the 'Spaces for Soccer' project and meet some of young people benefitting from this project — for dinner a special South African Braai in the Boma with a Marimba Band.

### AUGUST 26: FLIGHT TO MADIKWE

Early start for the drive back to Cape Town and flight to Johannesburg — by private charter aircraft to Madikwe Hills Private Game Lodge — true, untamed Africa set amongst giant boulders in the rocky hills — the savannah here teams



with game and the Big Five make their presence known — Operation Phoenix reintroduced over 10,000 animals here in an internationally significant conservation initiative.

### AUGUST 27: MADIKWE HILLS

Jeep safaris to spot the astonishing array of wildlife — elephant, rhino, lion, leopard, wild dog, cheetah giraffe, zebra, hippo, brown hyena, spotted hyena, springbok, eland, kudu, wildebeest, warthog, crocodile and Chacma baboon are some of the larger species to be seen — smaller species include rock dassie, African civet, genet, bush baby, porcupine, aardvark and antelope as well as the endangered Wild Dog.

### AUGUST 28: FLY TO KRUGER NP

Lodge hop by private charter aircraft north east to Kruger National Park and Sabi Sand — three nights at Singita, "the place of miracles", world-renowned for providing some of the best safari experience in Africa — enjoy the luxurious bush lodgings and look out for baboons trooping past your suite.

### AUGUST 29-30: SINGITA BOULDERS LODGE

Two full days of twice daily game drives with Singita's skillful guides — highlights might include prides of

lions, parades of elephants, crashes of white rhinos, dazzles of zebras, clans of hyenas, journeys of giraffes and frequent leopard sightings — opportunities for world-class wildlife photography are unrivaled.

### AUGUST 31: FLY TO VICTORIA FALLS
